### Court 5 and 6 Resurfacing update

The resurfacing of courts 5 and 6 is now underway and will be completed during August. There will be 3 phases of work:

- Groundwork: The court has been spiked to improve drainage, court edge repairs will be completed and new net post sockets and centre anchors installed
- 2. Tarmac laying: The new surface will be laid, compacted and rolled flat
- 3. **Painting:** The tarmac will need around 2 weeks to harden and then the courts will be painted in dark green with mid green outer
